- I. Call to Order and Introductions: Board Members and Team Reps in attendance introductions via zoom.

  - A. Co-President Report: 2021-2022 Secretary, Membership and Co-President in training are open, please consider one of these positions.
  - B. Treasurer Report: Mask Fundraiser = \$3600 with more available for sale. Dan Sommers mentioned that fundraising this year will be a challenge so the organization's goal is to raise half of what we raised last year.
  - C. Membership/Booster Rep Update: List is in good order; Booster Rep – a good job in filling positions – only a few open at this time.

Six sports going on is exciting, but a bit of a rollercoaster ride as they did not know what to expect this fall with Covid, it has been great to see athletes back on campus for those six sports as well as contact days! Everyone is doing a good job following Covid protocols. Contact days are going well, stressful on the facility with 30 sports going on on campus.

New girls basketball coach, Matt Weber has been formally introduced. New hashtag at Prospect this year #everyknight.

New wall decoration in school – want to respect and empower every Knight student.

Fundraising – we have re-set the bar with coaches expectations this year. Making sure coaches are very mindful and intentional with what equipment they may be asking for from the Boosters.

Discussed doing a monthly fundraiser with local restaurants.

  - A. Apparel – 95 orders total was \$780 for Boosters. Working on doing an in person spiritwear sale outside the school; need to get ok from school to proceed.
  - B. Golf Outing – 100 golfers signed up; \$6,000; Less than a month away, may make 125 or more for total headcount; \$3,000 in hole sponsorship. No banquet, food after 9<sup>th</sup> hole, events out on the course, no baskets this year, beat the pro competition planned, hole in one competition planned, online scoring app will be used; golf coaches will be bringing the flight scope out for people to see what the Boosters have done in the past.
  - C. Re-U-Knight – holding off on collections because of everything going on with Covid. Maybe looking at second semester when we have in person might be better.
  - D. Facebook/Website – everything is up to date. Frank mentioned that the school has purchased cameras to possibly stream

underlevel sporting events. Working to create opportunities for parents to watch remotely.

- V. Athletic Team Updates –
  - Girls Soccer – per Coach Froats, 40 plus upperclassmen and 20 plus freshmen signed up for contact days.
  - Boys Cross Country – 4 meets, Varsity 3-1 lost to Loyola. Frosh/Soph 4-0, meet tomorrow versus RMHS. Time trials under the lights on Friday night along with the girls team.
  - Boys Golf – Varsity and JV both 6-0 in MSL
  - Dance – hoping for virtual tryouts maybe for competitive dance
  - Girls Golf – 8-2 Varsity; 3 to 4 meets every single week
  - Girls Tennis – Varsity has lost one match, 2<sup>nd</sup> place in an invite, having a really good season. Coach says thanks for the windscreens! JV is 3-4, having a good season.
