Thank everyone for conversations with parents about ways to help athletes this year. Idea for Elite series came from those conversations. Good opportunity for us to focus on personal development. Phase four allows us to do a lot of things – start athletic contests for all levels. Keep positivity rate low where it is at for things to continue. We are region 10 – suburban Cook County. Allowing new practice time 7:30am-9:00am. Also taking into consideration for multi-sport athletes – partial overlaps. MSL is allowing athletes for the first time ever because of unique year to allow athletes to compete in sports that did NOT previously compete in the same season. Practices can allow 50 people in a designated space. Continue to reinforce the safety of wearing the mask – according to IDPH they have to be worn in school when people in the same space – worn properly!! Livestream – 1.) broadcast teams (Knight TV on Vimeo) 2.) Vevo – stationary camera that sits on a tripod 3.) Hudl – camera mounted on wall in fieldhouse follows the action. Via You Tube often. Re-evaluate how we are doing spectators for various winter indoor sports. Home fans only – 50 person limit. There is a code to scan for contact tracing and to verify you are symptom free. Question about how we watch away games: schools are supposed to be sharing web links. Coaches should be sharing those. Contact days for spring sports (football, soccer, volleyball, water polo and b gymnastics) will start Monday. Quarantine- today had to quarantine the entire sophomore basketball team after an opponent has tested positive.
