Senior N.N. won the 60 m and 200 m dashes at Huntley. Prospect girls took 2nd through 9th place in the 1600 m run and 2nd, 3rd and 4th place in the pole vault. Prospect relay teams were 2nd and 3rd in the 4x200 m and 3rd and 4th in the 4x400 m. The indoor season continues with the first invitational at Wheaton-Warrenville South on Feb. 14, followed by the Honenegah Girls Classic (near Rockford) on Feb. 21 and the Batavia Girls Invite (Feb. 28).

***Boys Track and Field** - Boys' Track & Field is beginning its 4th week of the season and has already begun making meaningful progress with training in all areas of the sport. We begin the competition portion of the season this week, as we travel to Proviso West on Friday evening to compete in an open meet vs. Proviso West, Proviso East, Conant, and York. With over 165 athletes currently registered for Boys Track & Field, it is exciting to see our kids get an opportunity to compete and to showcase all of the work we've done so far in this meet.
